NEW WEBSITE PROMISES TO EASE ACCESS TO INFORMATION

It's the same web address, www.lakeforestca.gov—but with a brand new look for Lake Forest's City website. The new site is loaded and optimized with information that you can see on your desktop, phone or tablet.

More information than ever is at the tips of your fingers through the City's new website, which went live in October. The new site, designed by Orange-based 360 Civic, is the first complete upgrade in a decade. It brings an improved search function that will suggest likely pages as users type in characters. The page also features prominent links to the most-visited pages.

Calendars and City news features are also easy to find.

Coming soon are a chatbot feature that will allow website users to type a question and receive their sought-after information in an automated response, as well as a new mobile app and Ask Lake Forest issue-reporting system.

The design is also more attractive, and all of the City's sites – the Sports Park, Etnies Skatepark, and the Economic Development Division – share the same design to make it easier for residents to navigate and better brand the City.

More than 637,000 users accessed the site for 738,000 visits since January 2022. The City's main page was the most-visited page with 72,610 visits, followed by the Sports Park and Recreation Center and Adult Softball pages.





POP-UP CITY HALL SHOWS UP FOR RESIDENTS

Have a question for City Hall? Maybe a suggestion? Visit a Pop-Up City Hall! Two Pop-Up City Halls are scheduled in coming months: one at the Chamber of Commerce "Elf Yourself" 5k on November 19, and another at the Farmers Market on February 8. Both events will be held at the Lake Forest Sports Park, 28000 Rancho Parkway.

Pop City Halls are designed to make the City more transparent and accessible to residents. They are staffed by members of the City's Communications

and Marketing staff and often at least one City Council member.

The "Elf Yourself" Fun Run happens at 9 a.m. on Saturday, November 19. The Pop-Up City Hall will be part of the After-Run Expo.

The Farmers Market Pop-Up City Hall will be Wednesday, February 8, from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m.

LAKE FOREST APPROVES COMMUNITY-BOOSTING PROGRAMS

B1G1 Gift cards and Catalytic Converter Programs Headed Your Way

Lake Forest residents will soon be able to buy a community gift card and get a second card of the same value free, under a program approved by the City Council in October. The cards would be redeemable at any local business that signs up to participate in the program.

The Council at the same meeting also approved two programs to help residents protect their vehicles from catalytic converter theft. Once fully implemented, residents will be able to have their catalytic converters painted and etched for free or receive a \$250 rebate towards the purchase and installation of a theft deterrent metal plate.

Community Gift Cards

The Community Gift Card Program is designed to help restaurants, hospitality businesses, and other local businesses rebound from the COVID-19 pandemic. Residents will be able to buy a card for \$25, \$50, or \$100 online and receive a second digital card of equal value. The cards could then be used at participating Lake Forest restaurants and local businesses. The Council allocated \$575,000 for the program, which will pay for the gift cards as well for assistance in marketing the program by the Lake Forest Chamber of Commerce.

City staff will work to get the Community Gift Card Program set up in time for residents to buy the cards for the holidays, and a link will be posted on the City's website, www.lakeforestca.gov. Similar programs have been produced in cities across California as a way to help businesses rebound from COVID-19 restrictions and their associated economic ripple effects.

Catalytic Converter Anti-Theft Programs

Residents now have more incentive to take steps to protect their vehicle's catalytic converters. Catalytic converters are targeted for thefts nationwide because they contain precious metals that fetch a high recycling value. In 2021, about 10 catalytic converters were



reported stolen in Lake Forest each month.

Under the program, residents who take their high-target vehicle to a pre-approved shop can have their vehicle identification number etched on the converter for free. The etching deters thieves because law enforcement can link a stolen converter back to the owner. Residents will also have the option of purchasing and having a local shop install a metal theft deterrent shield over their catalytic converter. Residents that opt for the shield program will receive a \$250 rebate on their purchase, so long as the shield is installed by a participating local business. City staff hope to have the catalytic converter programs up and running by December 2022.

The Council, which already approved an ordinance requiring anyone in possession of catalytic converter to prove they acquired it legally, approved a \$59,000 budget for the anti-theft programs.

CITY PRAISED FOR SANTIAGO CANYON SAFETY PROJECT

Installation of guardrails, reflectors, lane buffers, and rumble strips on treacherous parts of Santiago Canyon Road earned Lake Forest the top award from the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE).

The County of Orange and the City partnered to design and implement safety measures after they reviewed a collection of data on traffic accidents along the highway. They launched the highway safety improvement project in 2018 and focused on measures that would enhance driver awareness, improve safety for road users (including bicyclists), and reduce the likelihood of accidents. The safety improvements were completed in April 2021.

Lake Forest City Council and the Public Works department accepted the 2022 Outstanding Safety/Resilience Project Award from ASCE at the September 6 City Council meeting.

This is the City's third ASCE "Outstanding Project Award" in the past three years.

ELECTRIC BICYCLES

Electric bicycles are riding an incredible wave of popularity – although the two-wheeled vehicles are not always popular with motorists. Did you know e-bikes fall into different classes – and each class has its own set of regulations set by the California Vehicle Code?

DEVELOPMENT OF 65 SENIOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING UNITS IS UNDERWAY

The Meadows will provide 65 affordable apartments to seniors 62 years or more earning between 30-50 percent of the Area Median Income (AMI).

C&C Development and The Waterford Group are the developers of the project, which will offer 52 one-bedroom and 13 two-bedroom apartments right off Bake Parkway. Both firms have developed affordable communities throughout Southern California over the past 30 years and currently own and operate 3,000 affordable units within the region.

The Meadows Senior Affordable Apartments is the fourth affordable housing community in Lake Forest:

 The Arroyo at Baker Ranch, completed in 2015, offers 189 affordable family units.

NEIGHBORS HELPING NEIGHBORS

Ever wonder what you would do in a natural disaster – like an earthquake or a wildfire? Are you prepared?

When a large disaster happens, our first responders, because of the sheer numbers of people involved, may not be available to help immediately. That's when we need to rely on ourselves, our families, and our neighbors. Would you know what to do?

The City of Lake Forest offers the FEMA CERT training program to any Lake Forest residents. CERT stands for Community Emergency Response Team. The program meets on Wednesday evenings for about 2.5 to 3 hours for seven classes and ends with a disaster drill on a Saturday.

You will learn how to prepare your home and family to better face a disaster and how to help your neighbors. You will also meet some very interesting people, including first responders who help teach the classes and give demonstrations. Upcoming classes begin January 11, 2023.

- The Mountain View community is under construction on Raymond off El Toro Road is a multifamily affordable housing project that will consist of 71 units, eight units being reserved for individuals and families in the region who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness.
- The Portola Senior Apartments, at Glenn Ranch Road and Saddleback Ranch Road, will offer an additional 57 affordable apartments to Lake Forest once finished.

Completion of the Mountain View and Portola Senior projects is anticipated in 2023. The Meadows affordable housing project is anticipated to be completed in late 2023 / early 2024.

EXPAND THE FOREST—A Landscape Improvement Program

Expand the Forest is a landscape-improvement project that encourages citizen participation in tree planting and provides an opportunity to enhance the City's urban forest.

An Expand the Forest memorial tree is \$93. The application includes an approved tree palette and available parks. Citizen sponsors receive a formal Certificate of Dedication signed by the City Council.

The spring planting season is March 1 to June 1. Visit www. lakeforestca.gov/en/departments/public-works/expand-forest for more details and an application.

How to Participate and Apply

An application is required for participants of the Expand the Forest program. The application includes a selected tree palette of approved trees and available parks. Note that each park is preplanned to accommodate specific tree types and locations, so not all types of trees will be available for all parks.

Submit an application indicating your tree and park preference, along with a check for \$93 made out to "The City of Lake Forest." The fee includes a 15 gallon tree, location study, planting, staking, fertilization, and other maintenance as needed.

CASHING IN WHEN YOU RECYCLE

Every bottle and can you recycle eases the strain on our natural resources. And when it comes to recycling you have options. Using your curbside blue recycling cart is one way to help the environment but you can also cash in when recycling.

California Refund Value (CRV) is the amount paid by consumers when purchasing beverages in containers from retailers. The CRV is paid back to consumers when they recycle eligible aluminum, plastic, glass, and bi-metal beverage containers at certified recycling centers. Below is a list of local certified centers where you can redeem your CRV.

RECHARGE YOUR VEHICLE AT CITY HALL

Thirteen electric vehicle charging stations are available for public use across the Civic Center campus.

Plug in your electric car when visiting the campus for an event, information request, or just to recharge. It is \$0.30/kWh and no fee is assessed while charging your vehicle.

The electric vehicle charging stations is a part of the Civic Center's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) infrastructure. No taxpayer dollars were used to develop the Civic Center Campus and its amenities.

The Chargepoint stations are on both floors of the Civic Center parking deck, and on the west side of City Hall near Police Services. The Civic Center is at 100 Civic Center Dr.



LOCAL DISTRICTS EASE DROUGHT PAIN IN LAKE FOREST

You can't watch the news, turn on the radio, even drive down the freeway without hearing or seeing the ominous message: California is in a drought. Save water.

Southern California typically gets its water from two sources: the Colorado River Aqueduct and the State Water Project, which imports water from Northern California. The Metropolitan Water District (MWD) in Los Angeles brings the water from both sources to Orange County. Both sources are suffering from drought.

In Los Angeles, residents were forced to cut back on outdoor watering. The Las Virgenes Water District in Calabasas even went as far as to put flow-reducing discs in the water meters of customers – including celebrities – who used too much water.

The story in Lake Forest isn't as dire because of steps taken by the City's two primary water districts, El Toro Water District and Irvine Ranch Water District.

El Toro Water District (ETWD)

El Toro was founded in 1960 and serves nearly 50,000 customers in the western portion of Lake Forest and portions of Laguna Hills, Mission Viejo, and Aliso Viejo. ETWD also serves all of Laguna Woods.

El Toro was an early provider of recycled water, which frees up supplies for drinking (potable) uses. The district's distribution system contains more than 170 miles of pipelines and thousands of valves, fire hydrants, and water meters, along with eight pump stations and six reservoirs.

ETWD maintains 158 miles of sewer collection pipelines and 11 sewer pump stations. The district operates a plant that can recycle up to 6 million gallons of water a day and maintains 25 miles of recycled water pipelines. El Toro's water recycling projects have reduced potable drinking water demands by more than 500 million gallons a year.

The District's water supply is diversified among recycled water (17.5 percent), water from the Baker Treatment Plant in Lake Forest (39.5 percent), and imported MWD water (43 percent.)

Irvine Ranch Water District (IRWD)

Irvine Ranch Water District covers 20 percent of Orange County – 181 square miles – and serves 447,000 residents. That number swells to 600,000 during the day, including businesses.

In 1990, IRWD received 66 percent of its water supply from MWD, meeting 14 percent of its demand with recycled water.

Today, IRWD imports just 18 percent of its water, and has doubled its water recycling to meet 28 percent of the district's demand.

IRWD points to major investments to help shield customers from the impact of drought:

- 27 drinking water wells and 5 treatment plants
- 5 recycled water reservoirs and 37 drinking water tanks for storage
- · 25 million gallons of recycled water produced daily

The investments continue. The district received a \$12.2 million federal grant to increase the capacity at its Syphon (recycled water) Reservoir by nearly 10 times. That will allow the district to bank recycled water and use it as necessary.

Water efficiency has increased over the years. In 1990, the district used 70,000 acre feet of water to serve a population of 114,000. In 2021, 447,000 were served with just 94,000 acre feet.

IRWD also has rebates available, and even offers consultations with landscape designers to change water-thirsty turf areas into water-efficient gardens. Visit www.irwd.com

HOME IMPROVEMENT AND REPAIR AFFECTS THE ENVIRONMENT

Did you know that some of your home improvements and repairs can affect the environment? By practicing healthy household habits, homeowners can keep common pollutants off the ground and out of storm drains. Chemicals that run into the gutter reach storm drains, which run to our creeks and ultimately the ocean untreated. Many hazardous materials that may be used in and around residences during routine maintenance activities include:

- Oils
- Paints
- Cleaners
- Bleaches
- Pesticides
- Glues
- Solvents

Homeowners can adopt the following healthy household habits to keep storm drains and the ocean clear of polluted runoff. It is especially important as winter approaches because rain can carry the chemicals off driveways and other surfaces and into the watershed.

Required Activities

- Clean out painting equipment in an area where the waste can be contained and properly disposed of. Latex-based paints can enter the sewer while oil-based needs to be brought to a hazardous waste center
- Rinse off cement mixers and cement laden tools in a contained washout area. Dispose of dried concrete waste in household trash

- If safe, contain clean up and properly dispose of all hazardous waste spills. If unsafe conditions exist, call 911 to activate a proper response team
- Household hazardous materials must be stored indoors or under cover, and in closed and labeled containers. Dispose of them at a household hazardous waste center
- Household wash waters (e.g. washing machine waste, mop water) must be disposed of in the sanitary sewer
- It is preferred that pool and spa water is discharged to the sanitary sewer. However, pool and spa water may be discharged to the storm drain if residual chlorine is less than 0.1 mg/L, the pH is between 6.5 and 8.5, and the water is free of any unusual coloration, dirt, or algae. Call 714-834-6107 to obtain information on a pool drain permit. Pool filter media must be contained and disposed of properly

And that's not the only slide at the park – Baker Ranch also has a spiral circular slide. But wait, there's more: a third, smaller slide away from the main activity center is perfect for the park's smaller visitors.

Sliding not your child's thing? There's a rock to climb, full basketball court, baseball/softball diamond, and huge grassy area.

Reassuring for parents, the park also includes a parking lot and restrooms. Rounding out a full day: barbecue areas, picnic tables, and shaded picnic areas. Dogs are welcome, too, on a leash.

HICAP is a volunteer-supported program that provides free counseling and educational services for older adults and their families. You can arrange for an individual counseling appointment with a HICAP counselor to get the most current information available to help you understand health insurance regulations and coverage. If you want to know what benefits and services you're entitled to and how the health care system works, call and make an appointment.

Through working with a HICAP counselor, you will get unbiased information to help you make the best choices for your individual health care needs as HICAP counselors cannot sell, endorse, or recommend any specific insurance.

HICAP can help you understand:

- 1. Your rights as a health care consumer
- 2. Medicare benefits, including how to appeal Medicare and HMO denials
- 3. Medicare and health insurance jargon
- 4. Private Medicare supplemental health insurance policy benefits and exclusions
- 5. HMOs and how they work including emergency assistance with denials
- 6. Long-term care insurance

California Yellow Cab

Are you 60 years or older? A resident of Lake Forest and do not drive or do not own a vehicle? We have transportation for you with CA Yellow Cab! There are three options:

- \$2.00 One Way (\$4.00 Round Trip) Within Lake Forest city limits to non-emergency medical appointments, socializing, movies, etc.
- \$5.00 One Way (\$10.00 Round Trip) To and from non-emergency medical appointments to Saddleback Memorial Hospital, Mission Hospital, South County Orthopedic Specialist, Kaiser Hospital (Irvine), and Hoag Hospital (Irvine).
- \$10.00 Lost Card Fee A \$10 fee will be charged to any taxi participant who has lost their card and requires a replacement card.

For new program users to take advantage of the Senior Taxi Cab program:


- You must have a current DMV Identification Card verifying that you're a Lake Forest resident to take part in this program.
- Call 461-3408 to make an appointment to register and take your photo ID for the City of Lake Forest Taxi Program.

Note: All Taxi passengers must be 60 years of age or better. It may take up to two weeks from the time you register for the program, and take your picture for your ID card, for the card to be valid for you to make a taxi reservation. Staff will call you to come pick up your card when it is ready to be used. Once you receive your Taxi ID card, you will be able to make a reservation, and pay the taxi driver directly with either cash or a credit card.

- 1. All programs are subject to cancellation or schedule changes.
- We do not pro-rate any of our classes or programs; late registrants will be obligated to pay full price for the course.
- 3. In the case that we receive your Program Registration Form and the activity is full, we will put you on the wait list.
- 4. Please submit a separate check for each program with your registration form. Upon receipt of your paid registration, you will be a confirmed registrant for your desired class or classes. Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt. If you would like a printed receipt sent to you, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope when submitting your completed registration form.
- 5. Activities may be cancelled if the minimum is not met. You will be contacted if a class or program for which you have registered has been cancelled.
- 6. Please allow for up to 30 days for your refund to be processed.

Refund Policy

- 1. A full refund (minus the 3% credit card fee) will be given for any activity cancelled by the City of Lake Forest; the 3% credit card fee is non-refundable.
- 2. Registrations for City of Lake Forest Excursions are non-transferable.
- 3. Refunds will not be given for any portion of recreation classes after the second meeting of the class has taken place. If a refund is requested prior to the second week of class, a refund will be given minus a \$10 administrative fee.
- 4. Refunds are not given for any program that may be cancelled by the patron with a fee of \$10 or less per participant (per receipted transaction).
- 5. All Camp cancellations requesting refunds (for Little Wranglers, Creative Kids Club camps and Lake Forest Rocks) must be submitted by 5 pm on the Thursday prior to the first day of camp (Monday) will be assessed \$30 cancellation fee. All camp cancellations made after 5pm on Thursday will be assessed a \$60 cancellation fee. All refund requests for Little Wranglers and Creative Kids Club Camps must call the Recreation Supervisor at (949) 273-6975.
- Requests for Gazebo Rental Refunds will only be granted if the rental day is rained out or if the request is received one full week prior to your rental date. A \$10 admin fee will be charged to complete the refund.
