

Please include your address in your submission to have your home added to the 2022 Lake Forest Lights Map.


The City will post the Lake Forest Lights Map on December 12 when the voting period opens. The winner will be announced on January 4, 2023.

# **City Council Wrap-Up**

November 1: The City Council reviewed and approved an ordinance that created new laws allowing the Police Department to enforce violations specifically for e-bikes.

At the November 15 City Council meeting, the City Council approved the second reading of the ordinance surrounding e-bikes, enabling the laws to be formally adopted and go into effect on December 15.

The City Council agreed to allow SiFi Networks to install

a high-speed fiber optic network underground throughout the City. The fiber network will create several benefits for residents and businesses. This agreement supports the City's Strategic Plan goals of a wellplanned and technology-current community.
